Discuss/ Action K-5 English Language Arts Curriculum Adoption Emily Herring expressed concerns from some teachers about the whole group portion and mak-ing an effort to make teachers feel more comfortable with the curriculum adoption. Jay Stanish com-mented about the possibility of students figuring out who the slower learners are when working in small groups but that we need to communicate the importance of all students growing regardless of their level of proficiency. The administration noted that all students should learn the fundamentals before advancing to the next step. An overview of the program will be completed next week with more advanced training in August with the implementation of the program in the fall. **Motion** by Jay Stanish seconded by Maggie VanderWilt to approve the K-5 English Language Arts Curriculum Collabo-rative Classroom at a total cost of 82,875, prorated out at <math display="inline">64% of the cost to ENP and 36% of the cost to HR. Voting in favor: 4. Opposed: 0. Abstaining: 1 (Herring). The motion carried.

of fuel grade ethanol on the facility located in the SW 1/4 of Section 3, T88N, R19W, Hardin County, Iowa

This proposed permit modification represents an increase in the yearly withdrawal quantity from 266.8 million gallons per year to 320 million gallons per year, and an increase to the instantaneous pumping rate from 1,050 gallons per minute to 1,070 gallons per minute

The Department has determined that this use of water conforms to the relevant criteria (Iowa Code Chapter 455B and Iowa Administrative Code Chapter 567) and recommends the permit be granted. A copy of the summary report for the application is available upon request to the Department at the address listed above. Comments on the report and this use of water must be received by July 1st, 2022, and should specify the log number 31,806.

Pine Lake Corn Processors, IDNR Log No. 31,806, requests to modify a permit authorizing withdrawal of water from six existing wells, and one proposed Mississippian aquifer well, all approximately 200 feet deep; six wells are located in the SW 1/4 of Section 3, one well is located in the NW ¼ of Section 10, T88N, R19W, Hardin County, lowa, in the maximum total quantity of 320 million gallons per year at a maximum total rate of 1,070 gallons per minute for use in the production
